*Mr. Pollak was born in Yugoslavia. As a young child, he was imprisoned in the Rab
concentration camp. Alex and his sister were rescued by a brave Christian woman who
risked her own family's safety to help others. He never again saw his parents, who were
both murdered in the Jasenovac concentration camp. Mr. Pollak immigrated to Israel
and served in the military before studying in Europe and eventually settling in Texas,
where he has worked as an engineer and businessman. Alex has been instrumental in the
establishment of a Memorial Park in Kings Harbor to honor the memory of those who
perished at Jasenovac and other death camps during WWII.*
